Bill: 3rd Sub. HB 237 Lethal Force Amendments

Sponsor: Rep. Dailey-Provost

This Bill: addresses when a peace officer may use deadly force.

Discussion: Rep. Dailey-Provost introduced the bill. It clarifies that lethal use of force is not justified when a person is only a danger to themselves. Rep. Maloy asked about whether law enforcement can defend themselves if that person is threatening them. Rep. Dailey-Provost said law enforcement would be able to defend themselves.

Bill: 1st Sub. HB 301 Domestic Violence Training Amendments

Sponsor: Rep. Pierucci

Floor Sponsor: Sen. Fillmore

UASD Position: Tracking

This Bill: provides for domestic violence and lethality assessment training for law enforcement officers and reporting requirements.

Discussion: Rep. Pierucci introduced the bill. Domestic violence calls are the most dangerous for officers to respond to. The bill develops a domestic violence curriculum for Peace Officer Standards and Training. It also provides a lethality assessment.
