An example of the duties for this position is as follows:

Installs, maintains, and repairs water/sewer service connections and water/sewer lines.

- Installs new utility lines using a variety of power and hand tools
- Tears out and repair curb, gutter, and street in locating and uncovering broken lines;
- Performs miscellaneous cement work.
- Builds meter boxes and extensions to raise or lower existing boxes as needed.
- Installs and maintains pressure regulating valves, meters, and strainers, and monitors water reservoirs to assure proper levels.
- Installs, maintains, and repairs sewer connections and lines.
- Maintains and installs manholes.
- Operates rodding and power flushing equipment as needed to clear line obstructions and maintain system flow.
- On-call emergency after-hour maintenance & repair responsibilities. Must be able to respond to calls within 20 minutes of emergency calls.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- High school diploma or GED.
- One year of related work experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience which provides similar knowledge, skills and abilities.
- Must possess a valid Utah driver's license and good driving record.
- Must obtain a Grade I State of Utah Water Distribution within six (6) months and Grade I Sewer Collection Operator Certifications within twelve (12) months of hire date.
- Must complete OSHA Competent Person Training and confined space training within three (3) months of date in position.
