Bill: H.B. 33 - Political Signs Amendments

This Bill amends provisions related to political signs.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. Representative Chevrier asked whether the city that removes signs for violating this provision would be required to keep the signs and notify the candidates, and the sponsor confirmed that the city must do both. Representative Shipp asked if the political sign requirements apply to areas outside of municipalities, and the sponsor stated that it includes both counties and municipalities. Representative Strong asked how the Bill affects park strips, and the sponsor responded that in the initial draft of the Bill dealt with political signs placed in park strips, but the cities had concerns with that, causing the sponsor to remove that provision. The current Bill excludes park strips. No further discussion ensued.
