Bill: SB 102 – Animal Control First Responder Amendments

This Bill amends provisions related to animal control officers.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill and noted the number of municipalities that submitted letters of support, as well as the broad support from the law enforcement community. Senator Owens asked whether EMT licenses were required for animal control agents to become first responders and suggested that such training be considered in the future.
