Bill: 1st substitute HB 37 - Used Oil Management Act Amendments

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. No further discussion ensued.

Bill: 1st substitute HB 60 - Water Rights Amendments

Sponsor: Representative Shallenberger

Floor Sponsor: Senator Stratton

UASD Position: Support

This Bill addresses water rights and the state engineer's actions related to water rights.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the 1st substitute, which was adopted by the House. The substitute adds clarifying language. Representative Arthur asked whether the Bill limits who may protest based on injury. The sponsor replied that the Bill does not change existing protest rights and that litigation already requires a showing of injury. Members also asked who determines whether an application is beneficial or detrimental to the public welfare. The sponsor responded that determinations related to quantity, quality, and availability fall within the scope of water applications, while other considerations are handled by the appropriate state agencies. No further discussion ensued.
