Bill: SB 25 - Retirement Modifications

Sponsor: Senator Harper

Floor Sponsor: Representative Acton

UASD Position: Track

This Bill modifies provisions relating to public employee retirement and benefits.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. Representative Auxier asked regarding the provision for immediate vesting of employer contributions. She also requested to know the rationale behind this request and a clarification of the current process. The sponsor responded saying the Bill authorizes senior staff in the Attorney General's Office, including the Attorney General, to be exempt from certain personnel rules. This measure is intended to address the significant staffing needs within the Office by enhancing the ability to attract and retain highly qualified personnel through a more flexible employment structure. No further discussion ensued.

Bill: 2nd substitute HB 178 - School Zone Speeding Amendments

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill, and the 2nd substitute which completely removes the option of compensatory service. The House adopted the 2nd substitute.
