Bill: 1st substitute SB 146 - Industrial Byproduct Amendment

Sponsor: Senator Grover

Floor Sponsor: Representative Bolinder

UASD Position: Track

This Bill addresses provisions related to industrial byproduct reuse.

Discussion: The sponsor stated that this Bill allows an industrial byproduct to be used in any project for a highway or road, curb, gutter, walkway, parking facility, public transportation facility, or facility, infrastructure, or transportation improvement that benefits the public if the Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control approves, or has approved, an application to reuse the industrial byproduct. A Committee member asked why this practice needs to be codified, and the sponsor responded that previously only private entities were able to use an industrial byproduct. This change allows governmental entities to do so as well.
