Discussion: Senate Amendment 1, which address concerns regarding a lack of clarity about which offenses were included in the Bill by specifying the applicable code sections, was adopted by the Senate. The sponsor then presented the Bill. Senator Brammer expressed concern that the legislation establishes procedures that are overly complex, opaque, and difficult to follow. He indicated that the preferred solution would be to provide greater clarity and simplification. No further discussion ensued.
