Bill: 3rd substitute HB 147 – Government Form Submission Amendments

This Bill addresses when a government entity is required to provide an electronic filing option to a person submitting information to the government entity.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. Representative Hansen questioned how it would be determined whether a suicide was the result of child abuse. The sponsor clarified that prosecutors would be responsible for ascertaining instances of child abuse in suicide cases.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. Representative Thurston questioned the necessity of disclosing tax lien information and whether it was appropriate to release all such information about a candidate. Representative Cutler spoke in support of the Bill, explaining that voters are

better equipped to make informed decisions when they have access to more complete information.
