Bill: SB 238 - Property Tax Adjustments

This Bill modifies property tax provisions.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. Senator Riebe asked whether the proposed changes would make it more difficult or easier to appeal property tax concerns. The sponsor responded that the Bill would not change an individual's ability to appeal and would not alter existing access to the appeals process. No further discussion ensued.

Bill: SB 232 - Regulatory Impacts on Families

Discussion: The sponsor moved to circle the Bill, citing that the Utah League of Cities and Towns had not yet provided proposed language for amendments or revisions to the Bill.

Bill: 3rd substitute SB 206 - Multicount Appraisal Trust Amendments

This Bill modifies provisions relating to the Multicounty Appraisal Trust (MCAT).

Discussion: The sponsor presented the 3rd substitute which represents an agreement dealing with valuation taxation of personal property in telecommunication service. The 3rd substitute was adopted by the Senate. The sponsor presented the Bill. No further discussion ensued.

Bill: 2nd substitute SB 221 - Housing and Transit Reinvestment Zone Amendments

Sponsor: Senator Harper

This Bill amends provisions relating to a housing and transit reinvestment zone.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the 2nd substitute, which clarifies zoning and density changes that would impact approved programs, allow Community Reinvestment Agencies (“CRAs”) to issue separate notices when initiating tax increments, updates reporting requirements, and modifies the review timeline for project areas that have not yet been triggered. The Senate adopted the 2nd substitute. No further discussion ensued.

Bill: SB 197 - Transportation Funding and Governance Amendments

This Bill amends provisions related to the governance of a large public transit district and financial reporting of public transit districts.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. No further discussion ensued.

Bill: 2nd substitute SB 242 - Transportation Amendments

Sponsor: Senator Harper

Floor Sponsor: Representative Christofferson

UASD Position: Track

This Bill amends provisions related to transportation, including road usage charge, towing dispatch, and local option sales tax use.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the 2nd substitute, which clarifies the permitted uses of the Salt Lake County infrastructure loan fund, including how funds are allocated and to whom they may be distributed. The substitute also refines towing-related language in coordination with stakeholders and clarifies certain duties of the Governor's Office of Economic Opportunity (“GOEO”) with respect to Housing and Transit Reinvestment Zones (“HTRZs”). The 2nd substitute was adopted by the Senate.

The sponsor then presented the Bill. Senator Cullimore presented an amendment clarifying that the funds would continue to be used for transit purposes but would be moved into an account subject to legislative appropriation. The amendment was adopted by the Senate. No further discussion ensued.

Bill: SB 275 - State-Endorsed Digital Identity Program Amendments

This Bill creates the State-Endorsed Digital Identity Program.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. No further discussion ensued.

Bill: 1st substitute SB 228 - Community Reinvestment Agency Amendments

This Bill modifies requirements for dissolving a community reinvestment agency project area.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill and Senate Amendment 2. The amendment corrects several cross-references and clarifies that if development within a project area has not commenced, the required review must occur eight years after the day on which the agency approved the project area. The Senate adopted the amendment. No further discussion ensued.
