Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. There was no further discussion.

Bill: HB 554 – State Debt Collection Amendments

This Bill modifies provisions related to government debt collection.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. Representative Hansen questioned the degree to which government oversight was necessary to ensure the payment of debts.

Bill: 2nd substitute HB 507 – State Coordination of Regional and Local Economic Development Projects Amendments

This Bill addresses local and regional economic development projects and related provisions.

Discussion: The House adopted the 2nd substitute, which makes many substantive changes to the Bill. Representatives Albrecht, Walter, and Ward spoke in support of the Bill.

Bill: HB 365 – Taxation Notification Requirements

Sponsor: Representative T. Peterson

This Bill modifies truth-in-taxation notice requirements for a fiscal year taxing entity that anticipates increasing the amount of revenue generated by property tax.

Discussion: The House adopted House Amendment 3, which changes the effective date from April 1 to May 1, 2026. The sponsor then presented the Bill, and no further discussion occurred.

Outcome: HB 365, as amended, passed out of the House.

Bill: 2nd substitute HB 501 – Water Modifications

Sponsor: Representative Bolinder

Floor Sponsor: Senator Sandall

UASD Position: Oppose and amend

This Bill addresses regulation of the provision of water.

Discussion: The House adopted the 2nd substitute. The sponsor then presented the Bill. Representative Thurston questioned the increase in water rates, and the sponsor clarified that the

rate would be raised to 3%. Representative Albrecht spoke in support of the Bill. Representative Auxier questioned the role counties play in infrastructure construction. The sponsor clarified that the provisions would apply to any public water system that supplies water on a retail basis. Representative K. Peterson questioned lines 439 and 440 regarding the use of state funds and expressed concern about the breadth of the term. Representative Snider also spoke in support of the Bill.
