Bill: 3rd substitute HB 41 – Construction and Fire Code Amendments

Sponsor: Representative T. Peterson

This Bill modifies the State Construction Code.

Discussion: The sponsor motioned to concur with the amendments made by the Senate, explaining that the amendments extend the implementation date of the fee and allow counties to provide input on the Wildland Urban Interface (WUI) maps. The House concurred with the Senate amendments.
