### **Bill: 2nd substitute HB 429 - Special District Amendments**

Sponsor: Representative Pierucci

Floor Sponsor: Senator McCay

**UASD Position: Oppose**

This Bill addresses withdrawal of a county or a municipality from a special district under certain circumstances.

Discussion: The sponsor motioned to concur with the 2<sup>nd</sup> substitute adopted by the Senate. She explained that the amendments added a narrow component to the garbage collection district portion of the Bill and allows Salt Lake County to withdraw from a first responder district in a fair way. No further discussion ensued.

**Outcome: The House concurred with the Senate and 2nd substitute HB 429 passed out of the House.**

### **Bill: 2nd substitute HB 123 - Sex, Kidnap, and Child Abuse Offender Registration Amendments**

This Bill amends provisions related to registration on the Sex, Kidnap, and Child Abuse Offender Registry.

Discussion: The sponsor moved for the House refuse to concur with the amendments adopted by the Senate. The sponsor explained that the language adopted by the Senate contains a serious flaw that was recently identified and that a Conference Committee is necessary to correct the language. Representative Acton stated that it would be a quick and friendly discussion. The House adopted the motion, and a Conference Committee was created.

**Bill: 4th substitute HB 269 - Ambulance Provide Payment Amendments**

Sponsor: Representative Maloy

Floor Sponsor: Senator Vickers

**UASD Position: Support**

This Bill amends provisions regarding ambulance provider payments.

Discussion: The sponsor moved to concur with the Senate explaining that the substitute allows the fiscal note to align with the amounts appropriated. No further discussion ensued.

**Bill: 3rd substitute HB 507 - State Coordination of Regional and Local Economic Development Project Amendments**

**UASD Position: Track and amend**

This Bill addresses local and regional economic development projects and related provisions.

Discussion: The sponsor moved to refuse to concur with the Senate, stating that additional work needs to be done on this legislation. No further discussion ensued.

**Bill: 2nd substitute SB 123 - Privacy and Cybersecurity Amendments**

Sponsor: Senator Harper

Floor Sponsor: Representative Wilcox

**UASD Position: Track**

This Bill modifies provisions related to the Utah Cyber Center.

Discussion: The sponsor presented House Amendment 1, explaining that it clarifies that cybersecurity standards and best practices for government entities and local education entities are aligned with controls published by the Center for Internet Security. The House adopted the amendment. The sponsor then presented the Bill. No further discussion ensued.

**Bill: SB 238 - Property Tax Adjustments**

Sponsor: Senator Wilson

Floor Sponsor: Representative Eliason

**UASD Position: Track**

This Bill modifies property tax provisions

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. Representative K. Peterson asked how and when a county would need to notify other entities about what is occurring with the property tax adjustment. The sponsor clarified that the Bill requires the other entities to publish the consolidated list. Representative K. Peterson also asked how virtual participation would work. The sponsor explained that lines 530–532 and 604–615 clarify that instructions for participation must be posted on the government entity’s website, and lines 616–618 require the county, upon request from the taxing entity, to assist in facilitating virtual participation. No further discussion ensued.

**Bill: 1st substitute SB 232 - Regulatory Impacts on Families**

This Bill requires state agencies, counties, municipalities, and local school boards to consider the impact of certain governmental actions on families.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. No further discussion ensued.

**Bill: 1st substitute SB 324 - Outcome-based Investment Grant Pilot Framework**

This Bill establishes the Outcome-based Investment Grant Pilot Framework to provide a process for administering certain grant funding for projects using measurable outcomes.

Discussion: The sponsor motioned to reconsider the Bill. The motion was adopted by the House. The sponsor presented House Amendment 1, which was adopted by the House. The sponsor presented the Bill. No further discussion ensued.
